Happily, I have found a novella collection that is a worthwhile and entertaining read, and this particular novella is part of it, though it can be read as a standalone.Kathryn is a sympathetic, if sometimes frustrating, character, much like the original Catherine. Virtually unnoticed by males for much of her life, she is understandably confused and torn by the attentions of two men and the interference of her pretty cousin. Her naiuml;ve questions about ranching, cattle, and life in Texas made her relatable, too, at least for a city girl like myself.The tension between the fictional world and reality plays well in this novella, just as it does in Austenrsquo;s Northanger Abbey, where the line dividing the two becomes rather thin at times. Words are important in this tale: written words, those spoken, and even those left unsaid. Wordplay lends a fun atmosphere to this particular story, but there are also many truths waiting to be found within its pages, too, for those who dig a little deeper.I loved the tongue in cheek references to reading too much, the nod to fictional heroine Elizabeth Bennet always knowing what to say, and the gift of another Austen novel to Kathryn. These kinds of details added to my enjoyment of this sweet tribute to Austen's writing. I would highly recommend this novella to fans of her work and also those who enjoy Texas-set historicals. This fourth Austen in Austin novella is based on Jane Austen's Northanger AbbeyAs travel companion to her condescending cousin, Philadelphian Kathryn Morton dreamily anticipates a week in the Wild West as the best cure for meekness. After a long rail journey and a steady diet of gothic dime novels, she shivers, despite the Texas heat, at the ghastly tales of the Austin Axe Murderer. Kathryn has little time to fret, given the competing attentions of quiet rancher Harmon Gray and elegant gentleman Jonathan Wellington. With her new-found confidence and her boundless imagination, she sets out to solve the mystery of Hyde Park Cemetery before another student flees Austen Abbey. Only then can she return home to her English-born parents as an independent American woman. A woman in love. But on the stormiest of nights, Kathryn learns that solving the mystery may destroy a future with the man shersquo;s fallen

for in a big Texas way.
